Cash receipt may be obtained from the O/o Civil Surgeon, Nuh at Mandikhera.
- The applications will be submitted to **Diary and Dispatch Room** in the O/o Civil Surgeon, Nuh.
- One application will be considered for one post only. Application form without prescribed fee will be considered rejected, no separate information will be given to candidate.
- Preference will be given to the applicants residing in District Nuh. Any of the three documents out of the following to be produced for Local area weightage:-

(1) Passport (2) Votor ID Card (3) Ration Card with Address (4) Cast and Domicile Certificate with address and the photo issued by State Govt. (5) Parivar Pehchan Patra (6) Electricity Bill (not older than last three months)

- Relevant Post Qualification experience (any State Govt./Semi Govt./UT/any Govt. Board/Corporation) will be considered. Experience certificate should be supported with salary slip (if salary is not mentioned in Experience Certificate).
- The applicants must have to produce all original testimonials before the document scrutiny committee.
- No TA/DA will be paid to appear for Test/interview.
